The Town of Elizabeth is a Certified Local Government through History Colorado. The program exists to protect the town's architectural and cultural heritage by protecting its historic resources and providing incentives for historic preservation.

A presentation by History Colorado on Tax Credits and Grants was held at the Historic Advisory Board meeting on Monday, July 17, 2023 and is available below.
